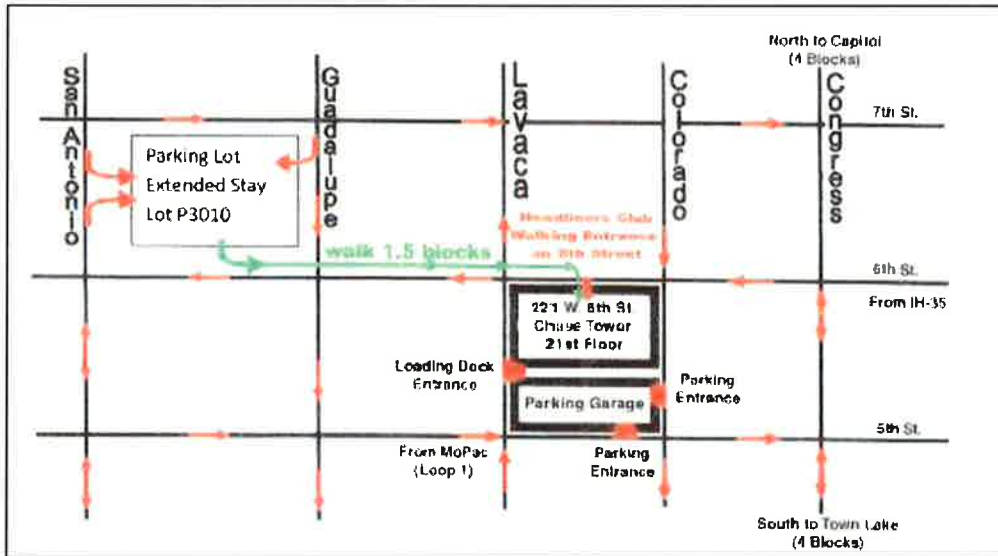

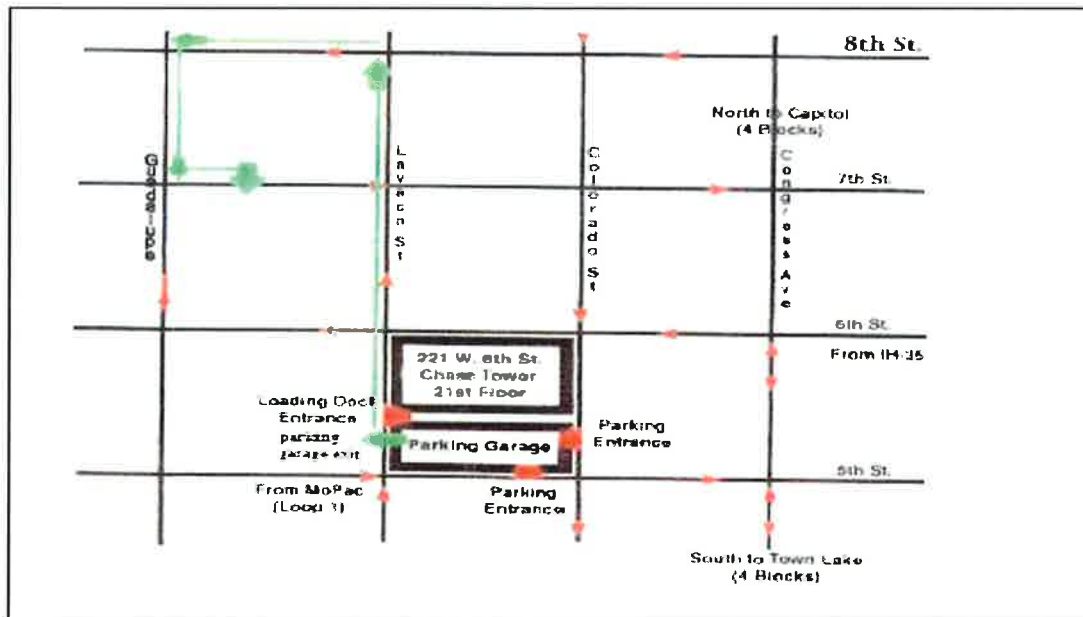

Chase Tower – Alternate Parking

Parking is available at 600 Guadalupe Street (connected to the Extended Stay America Hotel). Enter lot from either Guadalupe Street or San Antonio Street, and park in any unmarked space. Pay parking fee in Pay Machine.



Parking also is available in the Comerica Bank Building across 6th Street (where Gloria's is located).
